

DOWNER STREET CORRIDOR STUDY PUBLIC VISIONING QUESTIONNAIRE

As part of a public meeting on April 2nd, 2008, participants were asked a series of questions pertaining to the characteristics of the Downer Street Corridor. We are providing this questionnaire, with those same questions, for those who are more comfortable writing down their ideas and for those who were unable to attend but want to share their thoughts and ideas.

For those who were NOT in attendance at the public meeting, this corridor study is being led by the **Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC)**, and is being guided by a local Study Advisory Committee (SAC). The SAC drafted the following problem statement which will help you better understand the reason this corridor study is being undertaken.

Over the past decade, the Downer Street corridor has experienced significant commercial and residential development, which has led to concerns regarding the corridor's accessibility, safety, and sense of place. In light of continued expected development, the community recognizes the need for a corridor-wide plan to address the land use and transportation issues which contribute to these concerns.

1) What is most visually appealing about the Downer Street corridor?



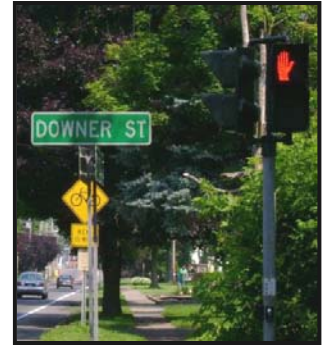
2) Are there elements that can be changed to improve the aesthetics of the corridor?
