The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) is currently in the process of completing the **Clay-Cicero Route 31 Transportation Study** on behalf of the Town of Clay and the Town of Cicero.

The purpose of this study is to develop long-term (10-20+ years) transportation and land use concepts that preserve and enhance the capacity of Route 31 while meeting the future needs and vision of the community.

So far in this study, SMTC staff and a Study Advisory Committee consisting of representatives from the Town of Clay, Town of Cicero, New York State Department of Transportation, Onondaga County Department of Transportation, Syracuse-Onondaga County Planning Agency, Onondaga County Office of Economic Development, and others have evaluated existing conditions in the study area, developed study goals, and developed and analyzed a preliminary set of alternative scenarios for future land use and transportation development in the Town of Clay and Town of Cicero.
