SMTC Schedules Public Meeting Regarding Long Range Transportation Plan 2011 Update

SYRACUSE, N.Y. -- The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) will be holding a public meeting for its draft **Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) 2011 Update** on **Tuesday, July 12, 2011** at the offices of the SMTC from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. The public meeting will be held in the lower level conference room located at the SMTC offices: 100 Clinton Square, 126 N. Salina Street, Syracuse, NY 13202.

The LRTP is a blueprint to guide the Syracuse Metropolitan Area's transportation development over a 25-year period. Updated every four years to reflect changing conditions and new planning principles, the **LRTP 2011 Update** looks at major urban transportation planning issues such as environmental/air quality; complete access to transportation; alternative transportation modes (i.e. bicycle and pedestrian); the impact of land development on the transportation system; highway traffic congestion; and maintenance of the existing infrastructure. Also included is the **Conformity Analysis**, which successfully determined that the SMTC is in conformity with the applicable New York State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality in its adoption of a Transportation Improvement Program, Long Range Transportation Plan, and any pertinent amendments or updates.

A public review/comment period for the draft 2011 Update commenced on June 20, 2011. **Comments received on or before July 19, 2011 will be considered for the final 2011 LRTP Update**, to be presented to the SMTC Policy Committee for adoption on July 21, 2011.
