A small sampling of suggested ideas to be *considered* for inclusion in the Draft Final Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan Document include:

- Repair and sweep streets/shoulders where travel conditions are not adequate for proper bicycle travel.
- Widespread distribution of Bike Maps.
- Connect residential areas with sidewalks (connectivity of sidewalks).
- Educate municipalities on how to obtain funding for various bicycle and pedestrian amenities.
- Talk with developers about bicycle and pedestrian facilities while development is occurring (may be possible to find money for facilities).
- Determine best/fastest way to link trails (do the easiest ones first to generate excitement amongst communities).
- Market mass transit to bicyclists (i.e. bicycle racks on Centro buses).
- Create attractive financial incentives to ride Centro.
