ANNOUNCEMENT OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AMENDMENT TO THE 2007-2012 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) is seeking public comment on the proposed amendments relative to the existing 2007-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This action includes the following:

- Addition of projects
 - PIN 3M1001 (Bridge Clean and Wash 2010) Total Cost \$494,000
 - Sponsor New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT). Project will provide funding for preventive maintenance activities to preserve the service life of various bridges in Onondaga County.
 - PIN 350163 (I-81 Bridges over Oneida Lake/Barge Canal) Cost \$360,000
 - Sponsor NYSDOT. Funds will be utilized to inspect specific bridge elements.
 - Following the FY 2009 Section 5310 solicitation that was completed by the New York State Department of Transportation, two project sponsors in Onondaga County were selected for the receipt of funding. The sponsors are listed below, followed by total project cost:
 - Loretto/PACE CNY – purchase four vehicles (\$202,737)
 - St. Camillus Health & Rehabilitation Center – purchase two vehicles (\$87,651)
- Cost adjustment to existing project
 - PIN 350638 (Rt. 695 On Ramp from Rt. 931B over State Fair Blvd & CSX and Ped. Bridge over I690, Town of Geddes)
 - Sponsor NYSDOT. Cost increase to Construction and Inspection phases in the amount of \$888,000. Offset provided from PINs 303768, 360197 and 360208.
